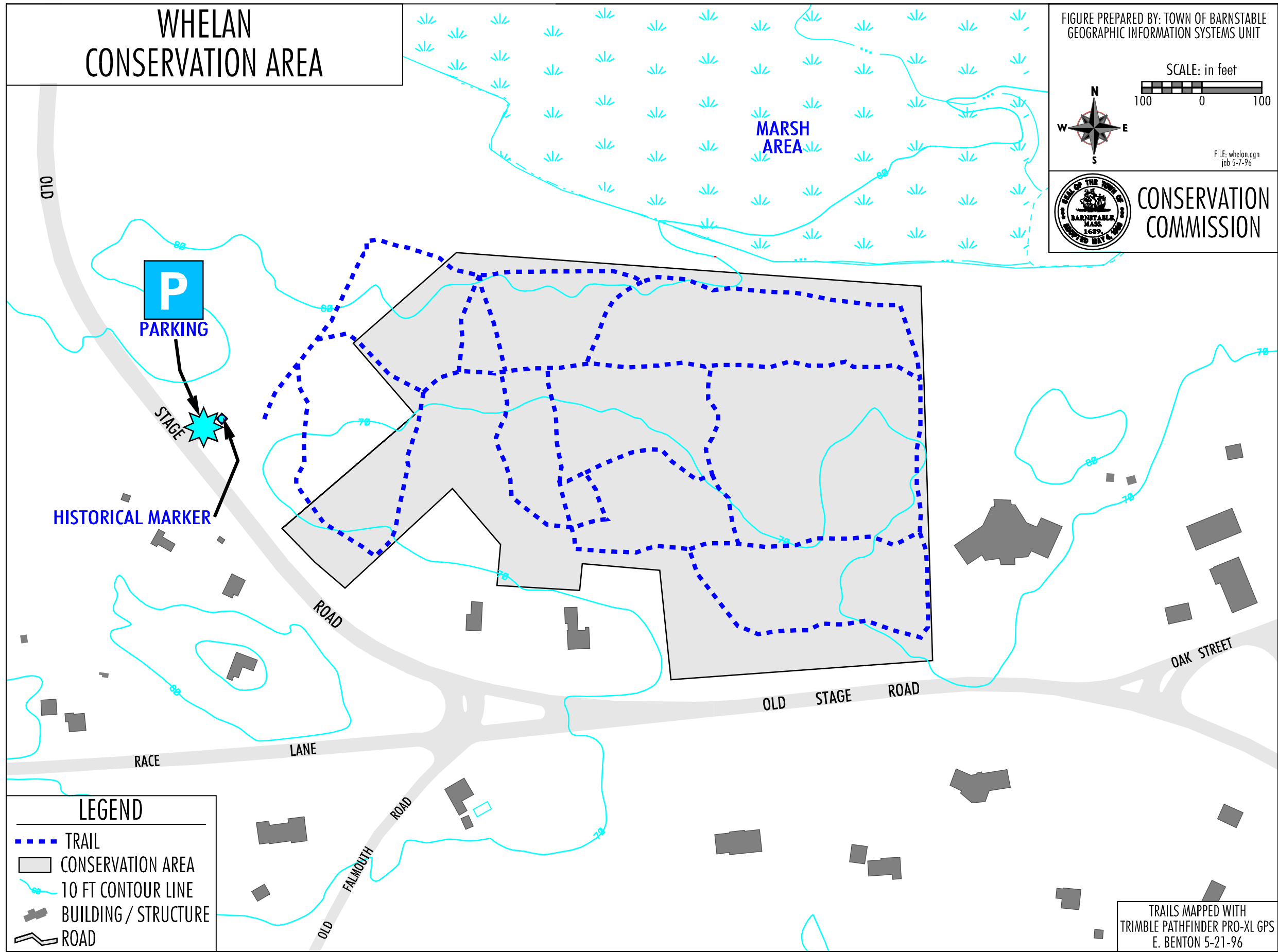
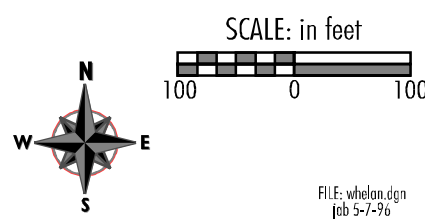

# WHELAN CONSERVATION AREA

**DIRECTIONS:** From Rt. 28 at the Centerville lights, follow Old Stage Road north. Bear right at the Rt. 6 sign. The trailhead parking area is another 1/10 mile on the right.

**SITE DESCRIPTION:** Whelan Conservation Area encompasses 13 acres. The topography is flat, and the 1½ miles of hiking trails are both scenic and easy on the legs. A ½ mile interpretive trail meanders through a rare sandplain grassland. Hunting, mountain biking and horseback riding are prohibited. Cross-country skiing is highly recommended here in season. Check the kiosk at the trailhead parking area for additional information.
