## Centerville Pie Café Lands at Barnstable Airport

HYANNIS, MA (May 12, 2016) – The Centerville Pie Café celebrated its official opening today at Barnstable Municipal Airport. Local business leaders, dignitaries, airport travelers and residents were on hand for the celebration, which included a “pie cutting” ceremony in lieu of the traditional ribbon cutting.

This is the second restaurant location for the Centerville Pie Company, which also operates a restaurant and bakery at its flagship location in Centerville. Located in the main terminal, the new café will offer breakfast and lunch daily. In addition to catering to airport travelers, the café is easily accessible to all in town. The parking lot features free parking for restaurant patrons, several reserved spots designated with “Pie-ority Parking” signs, and convenient curbside takeout.

“We had hoped to have a restaurant that could accommodate our traveling customers, our many airport employees as well as the residents of Cape Cod,” said Bud Breault, Barnstable Municipal Airport Manager. “Centerville Pie is that and more. Having them right here in the main terminal will also allow people to enjoy a quick bite between flights or offer carry out options for people traveling to greater destinations.”

Today’s grand opening coincided with the return of JetBlue service between New York and Hyannis for the third season. Passengers aboard the inaugural flight were greeted with complimentary pie bites.

“The opportunity to open a second location in the airport presented a unique and exciting opportunity,” said Laurie Bowen, Co-owner of The Centerville Pie Company. “We’re thrilled to be able to serve both our local customers and those traveling from off-Cape. We’ll have frozen pies and freezer bags available for those who want to take pies on their flights. And for local residents, they can call ahead and we’ll

bring their orders right outside to their cars. We're all about delivering high quality food in a fast-paced, convenient manner."

The Centerville Pie Café menu will offer the company's famous savory and sweet pies, along with soups, salads, sandwiches, and dessert items. Frozen dinner pies and full size sweet pies are also available for those who want to savor their sweets at home. The restaurant will be open daily from 6 am – 2 pm.
