NEW BUSINESS:

F0919-01 – Review and Discuss Proposed Scope of Work and Fee for ongoing evaluations of Perfluorooctanoic acid (PFAS) Compounds and 1, 4-dioxane associated with historical airfield operations of firefighting foam use

- Manager Servis stated the airport is completing an ongoing investigation in regards to PFAS analysis and reporting for historical use of firefighting foam.
- As part of the plan, the Airport must provide analysis and continued reporting, as required by the MassDEP-Massachusetts General Law, the Massachusetts Contingency Plan.
- Currently we are at the Response and Risk Reduction Phase of our response.
- The following are still required:
 - Additional Sampling
 - Tier II Reporting
 - Mitigation
 - Ongoing testing of affected areas
- To date we have spent \$ 260,000.00 on reporting requirements and will need an additional \$ 100,000.00 to get through the next phases.
- In FY2020 we have an approved appropriation of \$100,000.00.
- Motion was made by Commissioner Weill and seconded by Commissioner DellaMorte to approve and move item to the September 17th, 2019 Full Commission Meeting.

Agenda item Proposed Scope of Work and Fees going forward were moved to the September 17th, 2019 Full Commission meeting for approval.

F0919-02 – Review and discuss the 3-year on-call contract by and between the Barnstable Municipal Airport Commission and Fennick McCredie Architecture LTD

- Manager Servis stated the Airport completed the Request for Proposal (RPF) requirements.
- We received a proposal from Fennick & McCerdie, who is also our existing on-call firm.
- The Massachusetts General Law Chapter 7C Designer Selection requires an evaluation committee be selected to review proposals.
- The committee reviewed the qualifications of the proposal and their past performance for the Airport over the past three years of their existing contract.
- At the August 27th, 2019 Full Commission meeting their BID was accepted and approved.
- Motion was made by Commissioner Weill and seconded by Commissioner Bierwirth to approve and move item to the September 17th, 2019 Full Commission Meeting.

Agenda item for their contract was moved to the September 17th, 2019 Full Commission meeting for approval.

<u>F0919-03</u> – Review and Discuss contract by and between the Barnstable Municipal Airport Commission and McFarland Johnson to complete the Airport Master Plan.

- Manager Servis stated the Airport received a grant from the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA)/State for the Master Plan in July 2019.
- Motion was made by Commissioner DellaMorte and seconded by Commissioner Bierwirth to approve and move item to the September 17th, 2019 Full Commission Meeting.

Agenda item for McFarland & Johnson contract to complete the Master Plan was moved to the September 17th, 2019 Full Commission meeting for approval.
