

I am writing to express my interest in the currently vacant Barnstable Housing Committee position. As a LoanDepot mortgage lender on Cape Cod, I focus my business on assisting local Cape Codder's seeking homeownership. The current housing crisis and lack of affordability for our local neighbors is a critical issue that cannot be ignored.

In the past several months, I have utilized state down payment assistance programs to help two local families avoid homelessness who were turned away by other lenders. Families should not continue to be subjected to housing instability and be in fear of no longer having a roof over their head. It is my goal to help Cape families achieve homeownership and help promote change within the Town of Barnstable.

My passion for serving the community began prior to my current position as a Loan Officer. I received my degree from Towson University in American Studies with a focus in Homeland and National Security Policy. Post-graduation, I interned at Meals on Wheels American in D.C. in Public Policy and Legislative Affairs advocating for senior health nationwide and representing the non-profit at Capitol Hill meetings and briefings. In addition, I have experience in grass roots advocacy working as a Campaign Fellow on a Maryland U.S. Senate Campaign.
