Letter of Intent from the Barnstable Land Trust requesting \$175,000 in CPA Open Space/Recreation funds for purchase of a 3.47-acre parcel that is a vital link in the Cape Cod Pathways system; total project cost estimate is \$225,000. Town of Barnstable will be asked to hold the conservation restriction; BLT will own and manage the property. Property is addressed 0 Church Street, West Barnstable, Map 176, Parcel 006.

In an emergency, a public body shall post notice as soon as reasonably possible prior to such meeting. Notice shall be printed in a legible, easily understandable format and shall contain: the date, time and place of such meeting and a listing of topics that the chair reasonably anticipates will be discussed at the meeting. Meetings of a local public body, notice shall be filed with the municipal clerk, and posted in a manner conspicuously visible to the public at all hours in or on the municipal building in which the clerk's office is located.
