#### Call to Order

With a quorum present, Chair Lindsey Counsell called the meeting to order at 5:30 pm. Chair Counsell then read into record: "Please note that tonight's meeting is recorded and broadcast on Channel 18 and, in accordance with MGL Chapter 30A, s.20, I must inquire whether anyone is taping this meeting and to please make their presence known." No one was taping the meeting.

#### Minutes:

CPC Meeting of October 27, 2014 – Richard Sawyer questioned whether it had been determined in this meeting that if the costs of the CPC-approved Sturgis Library project were to be less than expected, any excess funds would be returned to CPC. Since this was not noted in the minutes, Chair Counsell asked Marjorie Watson to review the tape of the meeting to determine if this had been discussed and confirmed.

A motion was then made by Richard Sawyer, seconded by Terry Duenas, and voted unanimously, to table approval of the minutes of October 27, 2014, to the December 15, 2014, meeting.

## **New Business:**

2015 Meeting Schedule – A schedule of the monthly Community Preservation Committee meetings for the upcoming year was reviewed and accepted as submitted. (See attached schedule).

#### Letters of intent:

Funding request from the Sandy Neck Board through the Town Manager for \$200,000 for the restoration of Bodfish Beach Park and Sandy Neck Beach – Richard French was in attendance representing the Sandy Neck Board and stated that this request was being submitted as a placeholder. Mr. French said that Sandy Neck Beach and the Bodfish area are going away by virtue of the tides. In the latter part of October, a storm took away about 4,000 cubic yards of the 5,000 cubic yards of sacrificial sand that had been put in. The Board has entered into a contract with CLE to come up with a softscape design to protect the beach. Some of the funding will come from the Sandy Neck revenue stream and reserve and will hopefully match whatever the CPC may approve. He stated that he doesn't anticipate that the Board will need to come before the Committee again until the design is completed in the latter part of 2015.

Mr. French responded to a question from Tom Lee, indicating that the design will be a detailed design and that it will need to be vetted through the Conservation Commission and State agencies. Mr. Lee asked if it would make sense to do a conceptual design

Mr. French then stated that they would be coming before the committee with a more detailed request with designs at a later time and asked the CPC to keep this as a placeholder.

Funding request from Habitat for Humanity of Cape Cod for \$100,000 for the creation of two affordable two-bedroom single-family homes on Old Stage Road in Centerville – Leedara Zola, Land Acquisition and Permitting of Habitat for Humanity and Reverend Doctor John Terry, Board Member, were in attendance to discuss this request. Ms. Zola stated that a Barnstable resident had donated one acre of land for two separate Habitat house lots, per Mass General Laws Chapter 40b, with the sweat-equity model of partnering with the families to build the houses.

A motion was made by Terry Duenas, seconded by Richard Sawyer, and voted unanimously, to move the funding request from Habitat for Humanity of Cape Cod for \$100,000 to the full application process.
