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#### MINUTES - CONSERVATION COMMISSION MEETING

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 by Chairman Dennis R. Houle. Also attending were Commissioners John Abodeely, Larry Morin, and Louise Foster. Commissioners Peter Sampou and Scott Blazis were away. Rob Gatewood, Conservation Administrator, assisted, along with Darcy Karle, Conservation Agent, and Fred Stepanis, Conservation Assistant.

The meeting was held in the Town Hall Hearing Room, Barnstable Town Hall, 367 Main Street, Hyannis, MA.

#### I REVISED PLANS project type revision

A. Pieper SE3-4163(from 5/15/12) construct addition, patio, & wall landscape restoration plan (cont'd. from 6/26)

The matter was withdrawn.

B. Rahilly SE3-4892 sfd footprint

A motion was made to approve the revised plan.

Seconded and voted unanimously.

#### II ENFORCEMENT ORDERS

A. Debra Boschetti – 32 Hawes Avenue, Hyannis
Alteration of a flood and zone and 100' buffer zone by reconstruction of a deck without prior approval
from the Conservation Commission.

A motion was made to approve the enforcement order as written.

Seconded and voted unanimously.

B. Michael Guarco – 141 Estey Ave., Hyannis
Alteration of the Barnstable Conservation Commission 50' buffer zone by the reconstruction and expansion of a deck without prior approval of the Conservation Commission.

Exhibits A through C were submitted.

A motion was made to approve the enforcement order as written.

Seconded and voted unanimously.

C. Wianno Club c/o Mark Williams – 329 Parker Road, Osterville SE3-3848
Enforcement order addresses the request by Wianno Club to remove the two pipes at 4<sup>th</sup> Tee that were placed without prior approval from the Conservation Commission, instead of filing NOI to try and seek approval.

A motion was made to approve the enforcement order as written.

Seconded and voted unanimously.

D. Lisa Tzellas – Barnstable Village LLC (Market) – 3214 Main Street/ RTE 6A SE3-0982
 Alteration of the Barnstable Conservation Commission 50' undisturbed buffer zone.
 Violation of ongoing condition in SE3-0982 by failing to maintain 20' buffer strip from top of bank, under SE3-0982. Bringing in fill, removal of understory and one tree, associated grading with bobcat, brush and debris over bank.

Exhibits A though C (1-5) were submitted.

A motion was made to approve the enforcement order as written.

Seconded and voted unanimously

E. Ronald Crisp – 67 Pilots Way, West Barnstable SE3-3837 Violation of an Order of Conditions and Ongoing Conditions. Activities within 50' buffer: removal or failure to maintain sections of single rail fencing, goats and wire fencing along edge of marsh, additional shed for goats near marsh, turkey coop and fencing. Large pile of fire wood within proximity of single rail fence.

Exhibits A (1-4) through C (1-4) were submitted.

All violations identified in the enforcement order have been corrected as confirmed by photographs shown at the hearing and in the file.

A motion was made to approve the enforcement order as written.

Seconded and voted unanimously

F. Susan F. Curran – 60 Madison Ave., Centerville
Failure to comply with an enforcement order dated June 15, 2012. Failure to retain an environmental wetland consultant to correct wetland violation near bog.

Darcy Karle, Conservation Agent, read a letter she sent recently to Mrs. Curran, explaining the Commission's position on the matter. Mrs. Curran had been asked to attend, but was not present.

A motion was made to approve the enforcement order as written, and as amended as necessary.

Seconded and voted unanimously

G. Guadalupe Amaral – 90 Uncle Willies Way, Hyannis
 Alteration of a wetland, Town of Barnstable Conservation Commission 50' buffer and 100' buffer zone,

 by
 clearing and grading a section of a vacant lot with a bobcat without prior authorization.

Exhibits A through C (1-4) were submitted.

A motion was made to approve the enforcement order as written.

Seconded and voted unanimously

H. Albert Testa and Ronald Palumbo – 22 Cameron Lane (15 Cameron Lane) Marstons Mills Alteration of a wetland. Unpermitted seasonal dock, on an easement off of 22 Cameron Lane, Mistic Lake.

Exhibit A was submitted.

The property owners have indicated that they intend to file a Notice of Intent to seek approval of the seasonal pier. Application is due by Sept. 7, 2012.

A motion was made to approve the enforcement order as written.
