McGuire SE3-5040 A. sfd footprint; half-rail fence The applicant was represented by Stephen Wilson, P.E. A motion was made to approve the revised plan. Seconded and voted unanimously. B. Seldorf SE3-4850 bulkhead add stair platform The applicant was represented by Peter Sullivan, P.E. A motion was made to approve the revised plan. Seconded and voted unanimously. C. SE3-4827 Mampoo pool/patio pool fence The applicant was represented by Peter Sullivan, P.E.

D. Popeo SE3-4959 boardwalk, pier revegetation

- The plan calls for meadow, as the phragmites area is not wetland, but rather dredge spoil.
