I REQUESTS FOR DETERMINATION

Robert C. & Mary K. Turnbull. To permit and maintain existing concrete slab for a bench, at 797 Old Post Rd., Cotuit as shown on Assessor's Map 073 Parcel 008-002. **DA-15037**

The applicant was represented by John C. O'Dea, P.E. of Sullivan Engineering and Consulting, Inc.

A motion was made to issue a negative determination.

Seconded and voted: 6 votes Aye; 1 vote Nay.

Shane & Fenton Peters. Construct addition with foundation within riverfront area at 70 Rosa Ln., Marstons Mills, as shown on Assessor's Map 061 Parcel 013. **DA-15038**
