#### BARNSTABLE DISABILITY COMMISSION MINUTES

May 18, 2011 Minutes Barnstable Senior Center

ATTENDEES: Raye Kaddy, Chair, Linda Cook, Vice Chair, Jean Boyle, and Jim Berks, Tammy Cunningham, Secretary. Al Melcher arrived at 11:45 a.m.

Also Present: Darcy Karle, Conservation Agent.

Meeting called to order at 11:35 A.M.

Public Comment – None

Minutes of April 20, 2011 - Motion to accept minutes by Jean Boyle; seconded by Linds Cook; unanimous. The Commission asked that it be reflected in the minutes a thank you to Tammy Cunningham for a job well done on the minutes.

Handicap Accessibility & Walking Trails – Darcy Karle from Conservation presenting to the Disability Commission. Ms. Karle explained there are seven main conservation areas within the Town of Barnstable.

In 2007 a handicap accessible 500' loop trail was built at the Santuit River Conservation Area in Cotuit. The area was chosen because the elevation was conducive to a handicap trail. The project in Cotuit was developed by use of grant funds and a town match of \$1,338 (including in kind services). (see attached report)

Ms. Karle stated she also reviewed the Crocker Neck property for creation of a hancicap accessible trail on the property, however, when it was reviewed the Funder of the project said trail was too far off the road. Two major components when deciding on a property are parking and the grading of the property.



A discussion was held on the overtime line heading within the project summary. Ms. Karle explained when possible Conservation utilizes the divisions/departments of the Town because most often it is cheaper. The Highway Department did incur overtime, costs, however, that was part of the in kind services matched by the Town.

Chair Kaddy asked about grants that were specifically designed for handicap accessibility. Ms. Karle responded currently the funding is disappearing. Ms. Karle then handed out a brochure of different types of handicap accessible materials used for surfacing.

Finance Report – The most recent finance report was distributed to members present. Ms. Cunningham reported she spoke to Mr. Milne about the disbursement of funds to Sturgis. The appropriate process would be to have Sturgis submit correspondence with a request for disbursement of funds and justify the need for the monies. This would allow the Disability Commission to remain in control of the project and know how the money is being spent.

The Commission had a discussion on expenditures of funds and how the money could be used. It was determined that a Finance Committee meeting would be held prior to the June BDC meeting to discuss this matter.

#### Old Rusiness -

ARC Donation – Ms. Cunningham stated she would submit the minutes for disbursement of the check to ARC in Mr. Nevosh's name.

End of Year Report – Chair Kaddy stated she would begin putting together the annual report. The report will include goals and objectives from the past year.

Beach chairs – Jean Boyle stated she spoke to John Gleason, Recreation, who will be conducting an inventory this year of the beach chairs. A inventory has not been completed in two years.

Self Evaluation – Will be done next year.

Surveys – Jean Boyle stated she and Al Melcher went to the Airport on May 3<sup>rd</sup> and met with the Architect and General Contractor.

Port a Potties – Jean stated she spoke to Bouse House concerning the handicap accessible port a potties and had received a quote via fax. Jean Boyle made a motion to approve the rental of two handicap accessible port a potties from Bouse House to be placed at Covell's Beach and Loop Beach for a total of three months at a cost of \$225 per unit including cleaning, not to exceed a total cost of \$2000, Linda Cook seconded. Unanimous.

Discussion on Libraries – Jean Boyle reported currently two libraries are under construction; Osterville and Centerville. The Commission discussed the most recent survey conducted at Hyannis Library and, determined they would send a letter to the next Acting Director, Carol Saunders along with a copy of the survey.

Contacts and correspondence – Linda Cook asked that the Commission approve the list of students accepted by the faculty. Chair Kaddy recused herself from the vote and discussion. She left the room during discussion. Linda Cook moved to accept the list of students accepted by the faculty and each student be provided with a scholarship of \$1000 each, Jean Boyle seconded (see attached list of recipients). Linda Cook stated she would gather the necessary information for check disbursement. Chair Kaddy returned after the discussion.

#### New Business -

Chair Kaddy stated the house bill concerning expenditure of handicap parking patrol funds is being brought back before the house. A copy of the modified article was provided to Members (see attached).

Chair Kaddy stated she has set up a meeting with Jessica Silver of the Hyannis Area Chamber of Commerce for May 31<sup>st</sup> to tell her the Commissions concerns. A letter had been sent to Ms. Silver noting concerns.

Next meeting to be held June 15th.

## Barnstable County Land Management Grant

#### FINAL REPORT

**Project Summary:** The Town of Barnstable Conservation Division is pleased to report that \$6,162 in County grant funds, along with a town match of \$1,338 (including in-kind services), were used to construct a 500' handicap accessible loop trail and parking spot, at the Santuit River Conservation Area, in Cotuit.

#### Did you complete project as outlined? Yes

The path was located and vegetation was removed. 1 ½" washed stone base was laid down with millings rolled out on top. An additional a layer of 3/8" stone was placed down and rolled. A back top parking space was created with a handicap parking sign. A bench was placed in the look out area. The view of the river was enhanced by vista pruning. Dead wood was removed around the area of the path. One large tree was removed from inside the parking lot layout.









Rigid Modular Deck on 2x6 Frames Loch Arbour, NJ




Rigid Modular Walkway Connection




Rigid Modular Deck Section on 2x6 Frames

House Bill #2883

#### An Act Relative To Provide Funds for ADA Compliance in Cities and Towns

Lead Sponsor: Representative Ayers

This bill would change the current language in Chapter 40 Section 22G, vestricting the local Commission on Disability's use of money collected through handicap parking violations. It also creates a special commission consisting of member from the local zoning board, 1 member of the planning board, 2 members from the local commission on disabilities and the chief executive or his designee", to conduct the municipal self evaluation survey and administer the transition plan.

Currently, Chapter 40 Section 22G gives the Commission on Disability the use of funds created by the collection of HP parking fines, after consultation with the Ascal person/committee in the municipality, in any way that benefits persons with disabilities. This bill would limit the use of the money to "assist in making public property and buildings in the city or town ADA compliant." This is already an obligation Under Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act. It also

This bill restricts the Commission's use of money to be used solely to meet obligations the municipality already has under Title II. It also puts the responsibility of conducting an ADA self evaluation survey and transition plan squarely on the shoulders of a special committee made up of volunteers who very well may not have the expertise required to perform such a task.

This newly formed 5 member special commission, that is responsible for the oversight of the implementation of the municipalities ADA transition plan, consists of only 2 people from the local Commission on Disability. Therefore, it is possible that people with disabilities are a minority voice on this commission.

The following list provides some current examples of how the monies raised from HP parking fines currently being used throughout the Commonwealth. H2883 will not allow these items.

Providing captioning at town held meetings.

Hiring police details to ensure hp parking is available to the residents and visitors.

Working with their local schools to provide scholarships for graduating students with disabilities.

Providing funds to remove barriers at public buildings that other may be ignored.

Conducting disability awareness activities.
