Barnstable Disability Commission Minutes October 17, 2012

Meeting called to order: 11:34

Attendees: Patricia Andres; Merrill Blum; Marc Grenier; Linda Cook; Anne Mazzola;

Public Comment: Not any

Report of minutes of Sept. 19, 2012- Motion by Raye Kaddy; second by Jim Berks; unanimous

Finance Report:

Merrill Blum reviewed the income on the statement for the months of August and September. Discussion ensued about reviving the HPP patrol. Mr. Blum offers to contact the town manager and set up a meeting to discuss this item. A representative from the SMILE organization of Sudbury who was present at this meeting gave an overview of the Sudbury HPP and its operation.

SMILE organization: Two representatives brought brochures and information about their non-profit that supplies special surf chairs for beach-goers with physical disabilities that impede their access to the water. They state there are 168,000 families with disabilities in Mass. Next summer, Smile's organization plans to make more surf chairs available. Also, logo's may be available. SMILE is seeking funding from a variety of sources, including the local disability commissions.

Follow-up items:

Parking meters – tabled to November 2012
Letter for Memorial Bench at Veteran's. Ann Canedy suggests contact with Town Mgr.

Disability Office:

Linda Cook states that an open-house will be provided sometime during the first quarter of next year to familiarize commissioners with the office operation and seek input for further direction.

Funds Approved @ previous Financial Meeting:

Raye Kaddy reports that commission member (voted) allocated \$10,000 for various project including \$4000 for scholarships (one for Sturgis H.S.; one for B.H.S. and two for Project Forward at the CCC College).

Also, funds to purchase tools for surveying buildings.

Ann Canedy motions to purchase 2 levers and 2 weights for use by survey groups when going to local sites; and requests that the H. R. department prepare a purchase order as soon as convenient.

Seconded by Jim Berks; unanimous.

Other:

Jim Berks and Merrill Blum raise the topic of the elevator in town hall that is currently non-accessible to those in wheelchairs. After discussion, members agreed that this topic should be taken up with the town manager during the meeting to be scheduled by Chair Blum.

The commissioners agree to extend an invitation to John Juris and Tom Perry to attend the November or the January meeting; preferably November if their schedules allow. Three items for discussion when meeting with the Town Manager are:

Benches on the beach Parking Patrol status Capital Improvement Plan

Recreation Dept. representative Patti Machado invites all to attend a sensitive training session scheduled for the spring. She will notify members of upcoming dates.

Raye Kaddy read into the minutes a letter to Steve Sundelin informing him that henceforth, the Fishing Deck in Cotuit should be to be added to the Town's maintenance list.

The members approved the new letterhead.

For the **2 foot** digital level: http://www.amazon.com/s/ref=nb_sb_ss_i_2_8?url=search-alias%3Daps&field-keywords=smarttool+level&sprefix=smarttoo%2Caps%2C163 (If you do purchase a level, make sure it is the 2-foot, NOT the 4-foot version. You should not pay more than \$140 for it).

keywords=door+pressure+gauge&sprefix=door+pressure%2Ctools%2C228 (Make sure that you get a gauge that measures from 0-35 pounds. You should not pay more than \$35 for it.)

Obviously tape measures can be purchased at any hardware or practically any store. You should get at least one that measures at least 30 feet. This will assist when measuring ramp runs.



Simple to use

SmartTool permits you to find level and plumb in two ways. For quick references, use the sensitive bubble vials. For highly precise work, use the digital display on the Sensor Module. It provides accuracy to 1/10 of a degree. But the real advantage of the SmartTool is that it also reads all the other angles bubble vials don't. So when you are not dealing with level or plumb, SmartTool quickly tells what the angle is and what the angle needs to be. And only SmartTool allows you to measure angles three different ways: degrees, percent slope, and pitch (rise over run).

Read in Degrees

Set saw blade angles to a fraction of degree accuracy with SmartTool. Assure there is no gap when you join 2 cuts together with .1 degree accuracy. You can easily duplicate a stair angle for setting handrails and never again will you be measuring top and bottom to make sure stair treads and rails are parallel.

Percent Slope and Pitch

Listen and Level Audio Feature


Have tasks where you really can't see the SmartTool but need instant feedback? Then turn on the audio beeper. When turned on with a single button, SmartTool lets you hear when your task is at level or plumb. This can be great when shimming projects, leveling buildings, pool tables or other projects where you need immediate feedback but are not in a position to see the display. This can leave your hands free to adjust, nail, or screw the project in place when you hear the beep telling you it is where you want it.

Hold

The hold button makes it easy to measure in areas where the digital display is not visible. Take the measurement, push the hold button, and then bring the SmartTool in front of you to see your reading.
