Meeting Minutes

The regularly scheduled Barnstable Licensing Authority Public Meeting was called to order at approximately 9:30a.m. on **Monday, October 17, 2022** and was held via Zoom Meetings.

With Chair Hoxie absent, Vice Chair, David Nunheimer was the Acting Chair for the purposes of this meeting.

Public Comment - There was no public comment made.

NEW LICENSES

1. Special One Day License – Entertainment Only

Application made by Dylan Moreno of 427 Main Street, Hyannis to hold the "Run Through the Storm 5k Run/Walk" event starting at Sturgis Charter Public School, 427 Main Street, Hyannis on March 25, 2023 from 6AM to 12:30PM. Entertainment will be recorded music as well as live amplified music

Director Hartsgrove noted the applicant is a student at Sturgis and is unable to attend but everything is in order. Hartsgrove noted that parents and faculty will be present at the event.

2. <u>Discussion on Special One Day License – Entertainment Only Application</u>

Discussion on PD report 22-47330 and the retro approval application made by Jacks Lounge, Timothy DiPrete, 373 West Main Street, Hyannis to hold a "*Birthday Party*" event on October 5, 2022 from 9PM to 12PM. Entertainment was provided by a disc jockey.

Represented by: Officer Chris Kelsey, Tim DiPrete, Grace Horton and Derek Horton

Officer Kelsey advised that on October 5, 2022 Barnstable Police Department officers responded to Jacks Lounge. Officer Kelsey advised that he had been told from two sources that on underage serving was occurring on Monday and Wednesday evenings. Both the manager and bartender were told this information. Kelsey noted that there was a DJ present and advised management that they needed a

special one-day license. He added that as the officers were leaving someone played anti-police music. Administrative Assistant, Erin Logan, advised that the one day application was submitted at 10:15pm the evening of October 5, 2022.

Tim DiPrete acknowledged two incidents of underage of underage drinking. DiPrete stated that he had reached out to Licensing regarding an entertainment license. He added that the wires to the outdoor speakers have been cut.

Nunheimer confirmed with Hartsgrove that she did not receive any emails from DiPrete.

Kelsey states the manager acknowledged he knew he needed a license.

Application represented by Bryan Scarpellini. Scarpellini advised that Subaru needs more stall capacity.

Application represented by Jerry Pace. Pace advised they took over dining service from Unidine. At this time food is grab and go. Flores confirmed with Pace that the cafeteria is open to the public. Pace added that they do have catering event that may not necessarily be advertised to the public. Flores disclosed that he is on the board of trustees.

Director Hartsgrove clarified that there are no issues with Flores being on the board

Application represented by Jon Bercume. Bercume has 31 years of experience in the hospitality industry. He has spent the last seven years at the Cape Codder Resort and is responsible for all operational aspects of the resort.

Change of Manager, Change Directors & Officers, Change Stock

C&D Shamrock Inc d/b/a **19**th **Hole Tavern**, 11 Barnstable Road, Hyannis to amend the Annual All Alcohol Common Victualler license as follows: Change of Manager from Christopher J. Doherty to David Cronan; Change Directors & Officers as well as stock to remove Christopher J. Doherty and amend David Cronan's interest to President/Treasurer with 100% ownership

Application represented by Dave Cronan. Acting Chair Nunheimer confirmed with Cronan that nothing is changing as far as daily operations.

5. Transfer Annual Wine & Malt Package Store License

Cotuit Fresh Market, LLC, 737 Main Street, Cotuit to transfer the Annual Wine & Malt Package Store license from Cotuit Beer & Wine Inc dba Cotuit Beer & Wine to Cotuit Fresh Market, LLC. The applicant also proposes a Pledge of the License to Cape Cod Cooperative Bank dba The Cooperative Bank of Cape Cod. Proposed hours of operation are Monday through Saturday 8AM to 11PM and Sunday 10AM to 11PM. The proposed manager is Megan A. Burdick. Noting the following premise description:

The premise consists of approximately 3,500 sq. ft. on the first floor of a two story building together with approximately 500 sq. ft. of storage space in the basement. The premises consists of 3 rooms/areas for the market, one room will be dedicated to the beer & wine display, two toilets and an office, and the basement storage area

Application represented by Attorney Doug Cabral as is Megan Burdick. Cabral advised the applicant is looking to take over the operation. Burdick has gone through alcohol certificate training. Carbral noted that there is a pledge on this license. Karlson-Lidman confirmed with Cabral that the entire market is under the same owner so there will no longer be a wall or door separating the wine and malts from the remainder of the store.

Continued from July 11, 2022 - Grand Café Restaurant, Inc. dba **Grand Café Restaurant, Inc.** 350 Stevens Street, Hyannis to transfer the All Alcohol Common Victualler and Daily Non-Live Entertainment licenses from Four Seasons Trattoria in Hyannis, Inc. dba Four Seasons Trattoria in Hyannis to Grand Café Restaurant, Inc. dba Grand Café Restaurant, Inc. Hours of operation 10AM to 10PM, daily. Daily Non-Live Entertainment is for recorded music and 3 TV's

Application represented by Attorney David Lawler. Lawler began by advising that owners are TIPS trained and have been running restaurants with alcohol for years. Decker confirmed that they had been operating as Grand Café under the Four Seasons Trattoria license. Both owners currently work at Four Seasons Trattoria in Hyannis.

Simone's Pizza Burger, Inc. dba *Ronny's Pizza*, 11 Ridgewood Avenue, Hyannis to Change the DBA from Ronny's Pizza to Simone's Pizza Burger

Application represented by Attorney Garry Blank as well as the business owner, Jefferson Palhares. Blank advised that Mr. Palhares proposed to change the DBA to Simone's Pizza Burger. There will be a menu change. Director Hartsgrove confirmed that Mr. Palhares may not operate under the new name until the Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission approves the application.

DISCUSSION

1. Discussion due to violations occurring on August 13, 2022 for Harbor Club dba *Trader Ed's*, 11 Willow Street, Hyannis – Seasonal All Alcohol Common Victualler

Officer Chris Kelsey advised of an incident at Trader Ed's. When police arrived there was a woman who was highly intoxicated and they were looking for her friends to get her assistance. The young woman was too intoxicated to speak and vomited. She was transported to the Hospital. It was discovered that the woman was underage and using a fake ID. While Officer Kelsey was still on scene another individual tried to get in with a fake ID. The individual working at the door advised the police accordingly. There was a third individual who was intoxicated and was somewhat belligerent and was placed in protective custody. Kelsey added that in his time as a Police Officer he has not had a situation like that in any establishment. Kelsey does not see this as being a regular occurrence.

Director Hartsgrove noted that item is just a discussion to have a conversation about mitigating future problems.

Wayne Kurker and John Shea are present. They note that there is new technology and kids are buying fake IDs. They have trained staff on how to spot fake IDs.
