Letter dated 9/6/2013 from Turning Mill Energy LLC re: Screening of Solar Array at College (Exhibit J)

Turning Mill Energy wrote to inquire if the Old King's Highway Committee would consider the installation of a fence to screen the view of the solar array. George Jessop recalled an existing fence on Phinneys Lane that is quite large, but it is painted green and blends in. Ellen Merritt believes a fence may be appropriate, but would also encourage the College to put a few trees in front where there are large openings. George Jessop would suggest a height of 8' and would require the fence to be made of wood. Carrie Bearse stated that she will respond with suggestions and request a landscaping

plan that includes plantings, a site plan and details of the height & length of the fence. A new application would need to be filed.
