Moving the driveway is a concern, being done for public safety. Richard Sawyer stated at our CPC meeting we were asked for funds to review the fields in Barnstable. Kathy Pina asked about the Nate Nickerson sign. Patti Machado and Lynne Poyant stated the sign will remain. Lynne Poyant stated DPW would like to evaluate all the fields at the schools and in the town. DPW was unable to be at the CPC meeting and they had specific questions about the funding that I was unable to answer.

Joe O'Brien – BLL Liaison, Joe stated after BLL report I have a clearer idea of what their ideas are for Bay Lane. Patti Machado stated this field will be part of the evaluation. Richard Sawyer suggested waiting for the DPW survey, as they are looking at needs.

Lynne Poyant stated that the Osterville Village Association sent a letter to the town asking the status of the project. DPW still evaluating, may be on hold due to field study. Lynne stated that the town manger would like someone from the Commission to be on the Design Review Commission for Veteran's Beach. Kevin Turner stated if anyone is interested please email me.

**Old Business** – Joe O'Brien stated concerned about the delay in getting a new member for the Commission.
