Cape Cod Fall 50 Presentation, Matt Auger - The following is on our website for registration:

CAPE COD FALL 50 **Saturday, September 30, 2017**

THE FALL 50 is a 50-mile running adventure for solo ultra-marathoners and relay teams of two to five runners. Capacity will be exactly 200 solo runners and 300 teams. The Fall 50 offers **ONLINE REGISTRATION ONLY**. **Note: Teams MAY increase in size from 2-person, 3-person or 4-person up to 5-person at the going rate whenever they change size. Solo runners MAY NOT convert to pairs runners or team runners.** Registration fees include the individual's entry, long-sleeve hoodie, finisher's medal ("bling bling medal" on a chain), water, Gatorade, Clif Bars, and unlimited beer, wine, soda, pizza, and other snacks at the post-race party & awards ceremony.

The race is from Provincetown to the Craigville Beach Association. Kevin Turner asked what the goal of the organization is. Matt Auger stated hope to build to a level to be able to donate to local charities. Kathy Pina asked is this going to be an annual event. Matt replied yes, Kathy stated might be an issue in the future. Discussion followed. Rene King made a motion to move forward for a pilot of the Fall Cape Cod 50 Run, James Tenaglia seconded. **VOTE - 4 Yes; 1 No; Passed**

Behavioral Health Innovators, Stephani Briody - Handout (Exhibit A) Stephanie reviewed the pamphlet she handout out regarding An Alternative Peer Group (APG).

"APG a place where teens come together with their peers in recovery to build a sober life that will sustain them as they integrate into the broader Recovery Community." Stephanie Briody stated Huston, Texas created this program and it is evidenced based and APG's work. Some of the key components are: clinical counseling; treatment decision support; peer recovery coach; wellness/fitness; fun activities; group accountability; integration into the larger recovery community. All Recreation Commissioners' interested in assisting. Kathy Pina suggested reaching out to churches. Patti Machado stated will work with Stephanie. Stephanie Briody stated taking our time to set this program up, get it right the first time, hopefully in place by early 2018.
