Have never seen anything like this; Kudos to all, they were a team. Renee suggested inviting the rescue team to next meeting. Patti Machado stated she would do this.

Joe O'Brien asked Patti Machado about a list of fields' priority. Joe Gleason stated they did a list and it was based on phases. Town will use it as a guide.

Liaison's Report – Richard Sawyer stated CPC has just funded a bike path study from Mary Dunn Road to Sandwich. \$700,000 has been appropriated to improve and restore McKeon Field. Richard stated sadly this is my last meeting as we, my wife and I have moved; pleased to have been a representative of CPC to have had influence with funding for Recreation. Thank you Recreation Commission for the pleasure. Kevin Turner stated you have brought character and confidence to this Commission and you will be missed.

Joe O'Brien stated Mike Clark is the incoming president for BLL, a donor has stepped forward and they are in the infancy stage of discussing upgrades to snack bar and bathroom facilities which would make it viable for tournaments. Joe stated the Bay Lane field is also a big deal to me and will be working with LL.
