BACKGROUND: Cape Cod Cooperative Extension grant funding, in the amount of \$6,815.00, has been secured for a one day prescribed control burn as part of the Crocker Neck prescribed burning project at Crocker Neck Conservation Area, Cotuit. A strict protocol will be followed as written in "Proposal to Conduct Fire Management Tasks" by Northeast Forest and Fire Management, LLC dated 09/30/2014. Crocker Neck Conservation Area was identified in the 2012 Barnstable County Wildfire Preparedness plan as an extreme wildfire risk area.

ANALYSIS: The Cape Cod Cooperative Extension grant funding provides the Town with costeffective means to address and combat wildfire hazards on town-owned or town administered open space tracts.

 SUBJECT: Appropriation Order of \$40,000 for consulting engineering services for the technical evaluation of the Stewart's Creek culvert and lower estuary

BACKGROUND: For many years, environmental conditions in lower Stewart's creek, in the vicinity of the culvert beneath Ocean Avenue, resulted in poor water quality, reduced water depth and the overgrowth of invasive plant species such as phragmites. To address these conditions, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) agreed to design and construct a water quality restoration project for Stewart's creek that involved replacing the culvert and conducting limited dredging, in order to increase flushing of the estuary. The culvert was replaced in 2013, but prior to the finalization of the design, the USACE eliminating the dredging portion of the project, due to unexpected site conditions.

ANALYSIS: Since the culvert was completed in 2013 and was placed into operation, residents have expressed concern that the project does not appear to be working correctly; that a mud flat is developing just inside of the culvert; and the area is plagued by unpleasant odors. This appropriation will allow the DPW to engage the services of a coastal engineering expert to conduct a technical evaluation of the USACE project, including review of the analysis, assumptions, project as constructed, and performance to date. Their work will also include meeting with local residents to understand their experience and concerns with the project.

FISCAL IMPACT: Funding for this project will be from General Fund Cash Reserves, which has an adequate available balance for this appropriation

TOWN MANAGER RECOMMENDATION: Town Manager Thomas K. Lynch recommends approval of the appropriation
