#### I. CALL TO ORDER:

Chairman John Meade called the meeting to order at 7:00pm

#### II. MINUTES:

Motion was made and approved to accept the minutes of April 27, 2010

#### IV. MOORING APPEALS:

#### V. OLD BUSINESS:

- Ordinance/Regulations updates – Changing the deadline for Marina and Mooring waitlists.
- Barnstable Harbor Update – There are 4 vacancies above the 4 already filled by charter boats. There have been 2 slips issued to date out of the 4 available. Construction update meetings are every Friday at 8am at the Dolphin Restaurant – public is welcome. There is no trailer parking on the west side. This summer the only trailer parking at Barnstable Harbor is at Blish Point. Updates on Barnstable Harbor are posted on the Town's website.
- Mooring Waitlists – The end of April, 219 letters were sent to people on 14 of our 22 mooring waitlists offering the possibility of a mooring with a response deadline of May 14 to express interest with an additional 2 weeks to get the paperwork in order and processed. More letters were sent out than we have available moorings due to passing.

#### VI. NEW BUSINESS:

Centerville River Parking Proposal - Recommending that Engineering Dept. take a look at the area and offer suggestions.

#### VII. CORRESPONDENCE:

Open meeting law information from the Town Clerk was handed out to the Committee.

VIII. HARBORMASTER REPORT:

Eric Shufelt reported that Bismore grant piles are in, Conservation Commission approved to have trees removed at the Marina at Prince Cove and a bulkhead survey has been done at there.

Joe Gibbs reported that there are jobs still available and are posted through Human Resources and is online. Shore side Pumpout stations at Barnstable Harbor and Bismore are operating. Pumpout boats will be going in the water any day now. With the exception of North Bay and Lake Wequaquet, all of the speed buoys are in. There are 97 people who have not renewed their mooring permits of which 24 have notified the office that they have given them up, 35 are in fresh water areas and/or non-designated areas.

The meeting adjourned at 8:26pm.
