I. CALL TO ORDER:

Chairman John Meade called the meeting to order at 7:02pm.

II. MINUTES:

The minutes of November 26, 2012 were differed to next meeting.

III. NOTICES OF INTENT (NOI):

Bornstein – 153 Freezer Rd (Barnstable Harbor)

Representatives from BSC engineering presented the project to the cmte. The owners of Barn Marine services spoke of their concerns. The cmte discussed the project and approved it along with highly recommend the dredging be extended to the abutter as shown on the presented drawings.

3 Bays Pres/Audubon (Sampson's Island Dredging). Lindsey Counsell and John Odea presented the dredging project to the cmte. The project was discussed and the cmte had no objections to the project. As well as encourage the dredging of the outside Cotuit entrance channel. The project would improve navigation. Mr. Counsell also spoke of the town pursuing a comprehensive town wide dredging permit.

IV. MOORING APPEALS:

Unfilled Rental moorings 2012. Both Crosby Yacht Yard and Oyster Harbors Marine had unfilled rental moorings in 2012. The cmte granted the appeal so they could renew their permits.

V. OLD BUSINESS:

Proposed changes to the mooring and marina regulations were discussed. The committee was all in favor to move forward with them.

VI. NEW BUSINESS:

Cape Marine Contracting request for a commercial mooring was tabled as no one was there to represent them.

VII. CORRESPONDENCE:

VIII. HARBORMASTER REPORT:

Harbormaster's Office applied for and received a Port Security Grant and the Town Council has accepted it. This will be for additional patrols and expand the camera system to the 3 bays area. Waiting lists must be received in the Harbormasters Office by March 15 at 4:15pm. Mooring renewals will be sent out February 1st. Harbormaster will be advertising seasonal positions shortly. Barn Harbor project 60% done and material is being moved to shooting range. January 31 is the end of dredging window. Slip deposits are due by January 31.

The meeting adjourned at 9:04pm.
