

Existing Conditions



Problem

- There are currently no pedestrian facilities on Ocean Street south of Gosnold Street
 - Opportunity to improve pedestrian safety and accessibility
- Additional risks:
 - Kalmus Beach entrance is located on a sharp curve
 - Location lacks proper sight distance for safe turning movements
 - There is a dead-end in the watermain from the Yachtsman Condos to Hawes Ave.
 - Dead-ends can result in impacts to water pressure; inadequate fire flows;
 and potentially reduced water quality



Project Goals for Ocean Street


- Improve pedestrian safety and accessibility on the southern portion of Ocean Street by constructing improved pedestrian facilities, including sidewalks and crosswalks
- Improve traffic safety at Kalmus
 Beach by relocating the access drive
- Improve drinking water distribution and fire protection in the area by creating a looped system






Project Features


- Pedestrian Facilities
 - Sidewalks
 - Shared use path
 - Shoulder path
 - New driveway
- Additional Lighting
 - Currently every other, or every two, utility poles have lighting;
 proposal includes adding lighting to all existing utility poles
- Resurfacing of Ocean Street
 - From Gosnold Street to south end of Yachtsman Condominiums



Anticipated Schedule

- Winter/Spring 2023
 - Complete design & permitting
 - Bid construction work
 - Kick-off construction activities
- Summer 2023
 - No construction from Memorial Day Labor Day
- Fall 2023
 - Majority of construction completed



Project Funding

- Approved by Town Council on April 28, 2022
 - \$480,000 for the Ocean Street Water Main Looping Construction Project
 - \$2,950,000 for the Ocean Street Sidewalks And Kalmus Beach Entrance Construction Project



Related Projects

- Gosnold Street Sidewalk and Repaving
 - Anticipated construction in Fall 2023
- Snow's Creek Culvert Replacement
 - Anticipated construction in 2024


Planning Assistance


