HYANNIS HYARTS CULTURAL DISTRICT



Meander from Main Street, through the Hyannis Village Green along the brick wave path and you will hear, feel and see the excitement of Hyannis Inner Harbor. Take in the views at Aselton Park. (Walking time approx 5 min.)
- 8 HyArts Artist Shanties**
